

Guide to Disable Popup Blockers for Virtual Visits

Details for troubleshooting the disabling of popup blockers for patients.

WINDOWS

Internet Explorer 8 & Earlier

- Click Tools, select Pop-up Blocker, and then click Pop-up Blocker Settings.
- In the "Address of website to allow" box, type (<https://mychart.partners.org>) the website you want to see pop-ups from, and then click Add.

Internet Explorer 9 and Later

- Click the GEAR icon (Upper right corner) and select Internet Options.
- Click the "Privacy" tab on the dialog box, click the "Turn on Popup Blocker" button to add a tick.
- Click the "Settings" button to open the Pop-up Blocker Settings dialog box.
- Type the website address in the address field (<https://mychart.partners.org>).
- Click the "Add" button and then click the "Close" button on the Pop-up Blocker Settings dialog box.
- Click OK.

Microsoft Edge

- Right-click on the Windows icon (lower-left corner of the screen), then click on Settings.
- Type "pop" or "block" into the search box on the window that comes up and select "Block or allow pop-ups" from the suggested entries.
- Internet Properties window comes up, with the Privacy tab selected. Make sure the "Turn on Pop-Up Blocker" checkbox is checked, then click on the Settings button.
- Pop-Up Blocker Settings window comes up. Add (<https://mychart.partners.org>) the URL address of the website for which you want to allow pop-ups and click on the Add button.
- Click on Close to apply the changes and close the window.
- Click on OK in the Internet Properties window to apply the changes and close the window.

Firefox

- Open Firefox.
- Click the "hamburger" menu icon (top right) to open the Firefox menu.
- Click Options.
- Click the Content icon located at the top of the window.
- Make sure that Block pop-up windows is activated (checkbox).
- Click the Exceptions button located to the right of Block pop-up windows.
- You will see the Allowed Sites dialog box.
- To enable the browser to recognize UD servers as trusted sites and, therefore, enable pop-ups from these sites, in the Address of web site field, type (<https://mychart.partners.org>) and click Allow.
- Click Close
- Click OK to close the Options dialog box.

Chrome

MAC

Safari

- From the Safari menu, select Preferences.
- Click Websites at the top of the window.
- Select Pop-up Windows.
- To allow specific pop-ups, navigate to the web page (<https://mychart.partners.org>), follow steps 1-3 and then select Allow next to the name of the site.

Firefox

- Open Firefox.
- Click the “hamburger” menu icon (top right) to open the Firefox menu.
- Click Options.
- Click the Content icon located at the top of the window.
- Make sure that Block pop-up windows is activated (checkbox).
- Click the Exceptions button located to the right of Block pop-up windows.
- You will see the Allowed Sites dialog box.
- To enable the browser to recognize UD servers as trusted sites and, therefore, enable pop-ups from these sites, in the Address of web site field, type (<https://mychart.partners.org>) and click Allow.
- Click Close.
- Click OK to close the Options dialog box.

Chrome

iOS (iPad/iPhone)

Safari

- Open Settings.
- Scroll down to Safari and tap it.
- Scroll down under General until you find Block Pop-ups.
- Toggle off Block Pop-ups.

Firefox

- Open Firefox.
- Tap the three horizontal bars at the bottom.
- Swipe left, and then choose Settings.
- Turn on the toggle for Block Pop-up Windows to block pop-ups or turn it off to allow pop-ups.

Chrome

- On your iPhone or iPad, open the Chrome app .
- Go to a page where pop-ups are blocked (<https://mychart.partners.org>).
- At the bottom, under “Pop-ups blocked,” tap Always show.

Android

Samsung Internet Browser

- On your Android device, open the Samsung Internet app.
- Tap the Menu icon (three vertical lines).
- Select Settings.
- Under Advanced, tap Sites and downloads.
- Slide Block Pop-ups to off (white) to disable pop-up blocking.

Chrome

- On your iPhone or iPad, open the Chrome app.
- Go to a page where pop-ups are blocked (<https://mychart.partners.org/MyChart-PRD/Visits/visitslist>).
- At the bottom, under “Pop-ups blocked,” tap Always show.

Firefox

- Open Firefox.
- Type `about:config` in the address bar.
- Search for `dom.disable_open_during_load`.
- Set it to false to allow pop-ups.
